## Canadian CC-130s in Iraq War 2003

Canada provided three CC-130s to support the U.S.-led war in Iraq reported Lt. Gen. T. Michael Moseley, commander of Central Command Air Forces (CENTAF), in his comprehensive document entitled "Operation Iraqi Freedom: By the Numbers" (April 30, 2003 by CENTAF, Shaw Air Force Base, South Carolina. [www.urbanoperations.com/oifcentaf.pdf](http://www.urbanoperations.com/oifcentaf.pdf)).

Canadian military spokesperson, Maj. Lynn Chaloux, denied that the Canadian CC-130s were used in the Iraq war, saying "We supported Enduring Freedom, the war on terrorism, not Iraqi Freedom, the war in Iraq." However, U.S. air force spokesperson Lt. Sara Banda confirmed that Moseley's report dealt *only* with aircraft used in the 2003 Iraq war, not Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan.
