The idea for peace-related research into the CPP was suggested by COAT supporter Susan Thompson. She contacted COAT coordinator, Richard Sanders, in late 2002 with an idea for a campaign to oppose a CPP investment in The Carlyle Group (a major U.S. military corporation with close ties to the Bush and bin Laden families.
