All of the weapons delivery systems highlighted in this issue of *Press for Conversion!* (pages 11 and 30) – embedded with their Canadian components and/or serviced by Canadian corporations – were used to wage the current Iraq war. Most of these machines of war were also employed in previous wars, invasions, interventions, attacks or other types of military operations. The following is a partial list including the country, year(s) and military code name for the operations in which these war machines were used:

Egypt (1956): “Operation Muskateer” [Suez War]

Cuba (1962): “Cuban Missile Crisis”

Korea (1976): Operations “Paul Bunyan” and “Tree Incident”

Zaire (1978): “Operation Red Bean”

South Korea (1979-1980): “ROK Park Succession Crisis”

Iran (1980): “Operation Eagle Claw”

Saudi Arabia (1979-1989): “Operation Elf One”

Libya (1981): “Gulf of Sidra”

Falklands/Malvinas (1982): “Falklands War”

Lebanon (1982-1983): “US Multinational Force”

Libya (1983): Operations “Early Call” and “Arid Farmer”

Grenada (1983): “Operation Urgent Fury”

Iran (1984): [Aiding Saudi’s to down two Iranian aircraft]

Libya (1986): Operations “El Dorado Canyon” and “Attain Document”

Iran (1987-90): Operations “Ernest Will” and “Praying Mantis”

Panama (1989-1990): “Operation Just Cause”

Libya (1989): [Two Libyan aircraft shot down]

Iraq (1990): Operations “Desert Shield” and “Imminent Thunder”

Somalia (1991): “Operation Eastern Exit”

Iraq (1991): “Operation Desert Storm”

Iraq (1991-1996): “Operation Provide Comfort II”

Somalia (1992-1994): Operations “Provide Relief,” “Restore Hope” and “Continue Hope”

Yugoslavia (1992-1996): “Operation Provide Promise”

Yugoslavia (1992-present): “Operation Sky Monitor”

Iraq (1992-present): “Operation Southern Watch”

Yugoslavia (1993-1995): “Operation Deny Flight”

Haiti (1994-95): Operations “Uphold” and “Restore Democracy”

Rwanda (1994-1996): Operations “Quiet Resolve,” “Support Hope” and “Guardian Assistance”

Yugoslavia (1995-1996): Operations “Determined Effort,” “Deliberate Force” and “Joint Endeavor”

Liberia (1996): Operations “Assured Response” and “Assured Lift”

Iraq (1997-present): “Operation Northern Watch”

Yugoslavia (1998): “Operation Determined Force”

Iraq (1998): “Operation Desert Fox”

Yugoslavia (1999): Operations “Allied Force” and “Noble Anvil”

Afghanistan (2001-present): Operations “Enduring Freedom,” “Fingal” and “Apollo”

United States (2001-present): “Operation Noble Eagle”

Iraq (2003): “Operation Iraqi Freedom”
