The idea for peace-related research into the CPP was suggested by COAT supporter Susan Thompson. She contacted COAT coordinator, Richard Sanders, in late 2002 with an idea for a campaign to oppose a CPP investment in The Carlyle Group (a major U.S. military corporation with close ties to the Bush and bin Laden families. See pages 6-7.) Richard suggested that the campaign be broadened to include *all* military-related CPP investments, and recruited several COAT supporters for the project. Susan then coordinated the resulting internet team of COAT researchers that included Philip Keinholz, Peg Tittle, Colinda Latour, Marc Azar, Janet Hudgins, Alan C. James and Diana Ralph. After painstakingly perusing the websites of hundreds of domestic and foreign companies in which the CPP invests, a preliminary report was completed in March 2003.
