

Wars, Invasions and other Military Operations

In the pages that follow you will find information on several hundred warplanes that have thrilled crowds at dozens of Canadian air shows. Seeing these lists of warplanes should bring to mind equally long lists of wars, invasions, interventions and aerial bombardment campaigns during the past 50 years. However, most people just don't know the history of these weapons systems and they certainly won't learn that gory history when viewing these warplanes at air shows. There, the horrific reality of wars goes totally unmentioned.

The dates in parentheses indicate the time frame of the war or operation in which that type of military aircraft was directly involved and do not necessarily reflect the exact years in which the warplanes in question were involved. (Some warplanes may have come into use during the latter half of a war, or, may have been retired from use during the war.)

Some military aircraft, like trainers, although essential to military operations, never actually appear in war zones. However, they *are* essential in preparing the pilots and crew who fly fighter, bomber and other aircraft into war. When training aircraft -- such as those with designations T-6A, T-28, T-33 and T-39 -- are listed below, it is because they were converted for use as fighters, bombers or for reconnaissance and were directly involved in the military operations noted.

Air show web sites very rarely provide *any* information on the military operations in which the performing aircraft were involved. The data provided below, on the known combat records of warplanes, was obtained by consulting hundreds of military-related web sites that focus on military history, particular military operations and wars, air force squadrons and military aircraft.

Here is a partial list of wars, invasions and military operations, and some of the warplanes that were involved in them. All of these warplanes are known to have performed at Canadian military air shows.

International Criminal Court (ICC) Treaty

The treaty to establish an International Criminal Court (ICC) in The Hague, Netherlands, signed by 139 countries and ratified by 76, will hopefully put political leaders and military personnel on trial for genocide, war crimes and crimes against humanity.

Although President Clinton signed the Treaty, he stated US opposition to it. President Bush is vehemently against the creation of this court because it would mean that US soldiers could be put on trial the next time they attack, invade or militarily intervene in the affairs of sovereign states.

In December 2001, the US Senate almost passed the "American Servicemembers' Protection Act." This act would have made it illegal for Americans to assist the International Criminal Court in any way. It also gave authority to the US military to invade The Hague to free US soldiers, or oth-

ers, whom it did not want prosecuted!

Section 9006 stated that: "The President is authorized to use all means necessary and appropriate to bring about the release of any person...who is being detained or imprisoned by, on behalf of, or at the request of the International Criminal Court."

On July 15, 2002, Amnesty International issued a statement saying that "ICC investigations and prosecutions for the gravest crimes should never be obstructed, nor should double standards ever be created for peacekeepers or anyone else." Amnesty said it is "dismayed at the unlawful decision by all members of the Security Council to oblige the ICC ... to exempt peace-keepers from prosecution. The Council acted on proposals initially introduced by the US, which opposes the ICC, and in close cooperation with the UK."
